The book has dealt with the changing trends of breast and cervical cancer in India extremely well and it is mandatory for all dealing with cancer in India to read and be abreast with the changes occurring in common cancers in India to deal with the problem effectively. Other topics such as oral cancers, Hodgkin's Lymphoma, hereditary cancers, palliative care, multiple myeloma, have been dealt with very well. Rich Indian experiences of the pioneers in the fields of Stem cell transplantation, limb salvage in osteosarcoma, palliative care, paediatric ALL, have

been well brought out in the book. Discussion about oncological emergencies will be handy to the house physicians.
